Funding energy efficiency and renewable heat and energy

Warmworks

Government funding available for people who are on an income of under £30,000 a year AFTER tax (approx. take home of £2500 a month) and live in a property with EPC D or below.

On average, will fund up to £10,000 of measures. Takes a “fabric first” approach.

Warm Home Check

Local authority funding available for people on a low income who receive means tested benefits and live in a home EPC D or below. Higher income thresholds for people with a disability.

Energy Company Obligation (ECO)

You are eligible for ECO if you are a core group customer from scheme year 12 onwards under the Warm Home Discount Scheme or you receive at least one means tested benefit and satisfy the relevant income requirements.

Options for self funding

Parity Trust

An ethical, not for profit loan company.

- Secured Loans from £1,000 - £100,000 available
- Typical rate 5.49%
- No penalties for overpayments or early settlement
- Later life lending available

Mortgage

- Extend your mortgage or re-mortgage to finance.
- Some specialist mortgages available which incentivise home energy improvements such as the Nationwide.
- The Government is looking at how mortgages can be used to incentivise home energy improvements. Measures being considered include voluntary targets for banks to improve the average [energy performance certificate](#) rating of the homes in their lending portfolio to at least band C by 2030.

Finance

- **BHESCO** pay as you save
- Interest free finance options from companies such as EON who offer solar and battery packages repayable over 3 years.
